**FR. VAL KYNE**, a Columban Missionary, will be preaching this weekend August 5/6, 2017. Fr. Kyne is originally from Clonbur, Co. Galway,

Ireland, and was ordained a Columban Missionary priest in 1972. He spent over 15 years on mission in the Philippines and has since been doing parish work in Ireland and England. He was recently assigned to Columban U.S. headquarters in Bellevue, NE. Today, Columbans minister in 14 different countries around the world. Despite government restrictions on their life and ministry, they support the forgotten church in China. They minister among the deprived and downtrodden Catholics in Pakistan in spite of great personal risks. They support the struggling church in Myanmar as that country emerges from decades of military dictatorship. They befriend the poor and forgotten in the Philippines and Peru. They encourage young people in various countries to become Columban priests and lay missionaries in order to continue spreading the Good News of God's love for all humanity.
