From a contact I have in Nigeria:

NIGERIA IS COOL...though with some high strives of political instability around the country. The current President is an Islam and wants to Islamize the entire country. So, Christians who oppose their teachings are told to denounce their Faith or die. Many Christians have been killed because they kept their Faith.

The Catholic Bishops Conference of Nigeria (CBCN) keeps admonishing us to remain focused on Christ and to keep praying. The clergy even are terrorised, brutalized, kidnapped and sometimes, killed by these Islamic extremists. We are hopeful amidst all these.

GREATER CLARITY OF EXPRESSION ALWAYS POSSIBLE

They can, it is true, be made clear and more obvious; and doing this is of great benefit. But it must always be done in such a way that they retain the meaning in which they have been used, so that with the advance of an understanding of the faith, the truth of faith will remain unchanged. For it is the teaching of the First Vatican Council that "the meaning that Holy Mother of the church has once declared, is to be retained forever, and no pretext of deeper understanding ever justifies any deviation from that meaning."
