Are you seeking to rediscover your friendship with Jesus?

Remain trusting in His love for them and in the Holy Spirit to guide you to serve them as best you can. Haven't been to Mass in a while and wondering where to start? Start by getting to know Jesus again through prayer. Many people who do not go to church also do not pray. An invitation to pray with your loved ones is an incredible act of kindness.
