# OLD FASTING RULES: (Pre 1962)

1. The Fridays in advent

2. Every day in lent, Sundays excepted.

The Ember days Which occur four times in the year. The Wednesdays Fridays and Saturdays Immediately after the first Sunday in Lent- after Pentecost. Immediately after 14 September. Immediately after the third Sunday of advent.

The vigils of certain Feasts viz. of Whit Sunday, the Assumption. Of All Saints and of Christmas.

N. B. When a fasting day falls on a Sunday it is kept on the Saturday before.

To fast consists in abstaining from flesh-meet, And eating only one full meal in the day, Which must not be before noon. Besides this, A collation or light refreshment is allowed in the evening.

All who have completed their 21st year are obliged to fast.
