All Souls Day, November 2nd is not a Holy Day of Obligation, but is a special celebration nonetheless. Ordinarily, a priest is not allowed to celebrate 3 Masses per day. However, on All Souls Day, the Vatican gives special permission for priests to pray 3 Masses as we pray for all of our deceased loved ones during the month of November. A priest is allowed to celebrate 3 Masses with one being for a particular intention, a 2nd for all of the dead, and a 3rd for the intentions of the Holy Father. I plan to pray three Masses that day, along with the Vigil Mass for Sunday at 4pm. If you have deceased loved ones who have died in the last year

that you would like entered into the Eucharistic Prayer, please email Brandi Warnke (contacts above) and she will get them to me. The Masses for All Souls Day are below. God bless!
